Mission

To build fair, worker-directed coffee shops that serve their communities and provide a replicable model for transitioning into fully worker-owned cooperatives.

Vision

- End poverty through democratic business models
- Empower workers as leaders, decision-makers, and owners
- Build a coalition of cooperatives offering shared services and mutual support
- Prove that local ownership can be scalable and community-centered

Values

- Good Faith Assume positive intent and seek mutual understanding
- Love Build relationships, support the team, and the community
- **Fairness** Share value, voice, and decisions equitably

Business Model

- Worker-Directed: Workers participate in forums, votes, and teams that influence pay and policy

- Apprenticeship Path to Ownership: Workers can become Members through a clear, mentored process
- Gradual Founder Exit: Founders retain temporary veto rights and profit share until shares are sold to Members
- Nonprofit Support Network (Planned): Centralized services for future Beanchain locations

Roles

Role	Description
Founder	Built the business, retains veto and profit share until transition to full coop
Member	Voted in after apprenticeship, shares profits and decisions
Apprentice	Mentored by a Member/Founder, trained for ownership
Worker	All baristas and staff, with access to leadership tools and pathways

Co-Worker Mutual Agreement

All workers commit to:

- Operate in Good faith with co-workers and customers
- Perform Duties to the Best of Your Abilities
- To Communicate Clearly with Co-workers
- Be on time or early for my shifts.
- Be kind, welcoming, and attentive to our customers and co-workers.
- To be curious and compassionate when misunderstandings arise.
- To not gossip or violate the trust of my co-workers
- To never resort to violence, bigoted language, threats, or cruelty.
- Following safety and shift policies
 Violations trigger Solution Seeking Sessions instead of immediate discipline.

The Solution Seeking System

A structured, compassionate framework for leadership and problem-solving.

Core Protocol (3 Steps):

- 1. **Introspection** Reflect before reacting
- Mutual Understanding Listen and clarify
- 3. **Solution Seeking** Create actionable next steps

Leadership Tools:

- Feedback
- Targeted Conversations
- One-on-Ones

- Solution Seeking Sessions
- Performance Reviews

It supports the creation of Living Systems—organizations that adapt and improve continuously.
